2024 Grants

The Gallia Community Foundation, in partnership with the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio, awarded 10 grants, totaling \$24,191, in 2024.

Dr. Samuel L. Bossard Memorial Library

This grant is funding the purchase of an early literacy station for children ages 2-8, providing young learners a safe educational experience on a digital platform. The station will include more than 90 award-winning, pre-loaded educational software titles – spanning everything from handwriting and coding to fiction and nonfiction e-books – as well as 5,000+ activities.

Court Street Ministries

In 2024, a GCF grant allowed Court Street Ministries to provide more than 2,600 six-day supplies of food – packed with vegetables, fruit, dairy, grains and protein – to Gallia County households who are unsheltered, atrisk and financially disadvantaged. This grant is continuing that assistance and helping the growing number of Gallia County families facing hunger.

E3THREEE

Research suggests that children start developing financial behaviors by age 7. This grant is supporting the development of a financial literacy program for Boy and Girl Scout troops in Gallia County, allowing local youth to earn badges in those areas of study while instilling important skills sets they will carry throughout their lives.





Court Street Ministries provides an avenue for area residents, businesses and organizations to give their time, talent and treasure in service to our neighbors who need a helping hand. GCF grants have helped the nonprofit provide food to those it serves for the past two years.



Of the thousands of individuals who rely on the Gallipolis First Church of the Nazarene's monthly food pantry for assistance, 28 percent are children, and 26 percent are seniors. A 2024 grant from the Gallia Community Foundation is helping to stock the pantry this year.

Easterseals Central and Southeast Ohio

An additional 201 Gallia County children, ages 5 and younger, were enrolled in Dolly Parton's Imagination Library of Ohio in 2024, thanks to a grant from GCF. This grant is enrolling more Gallia County children in the program, which mails them a book each month and puts them on a pathway to success in school and in life.

Economic and Community Development Institute

The Economic and Community Development Institute operates Women's Business Centers to provide wraparound support to entrepreneurs, helping them overcome barriers and create economic impact in their communities. This grant is supporting an eight-week entrepreneurship bootcamp to help Gallia County residents who have a new business idea or plan to expand an existing business.

Gallipolis First Church of the Nazarene Food Pantry

In 2024, Gallipolis First Church of the Nazarene served an estimated 2,700+ individuals at its monthly food pantry – with more than half of those needing assistance either seniors or youth under age 17. This grant is purchasing food for those monthly distributions of muchneeded community support.





As the local partner for Dolly Parton's Imagination Library of Ohio, Easterseals Central and Southeast Ohio covers half of the cost of the books provided to Gallia County children enrolled in the program – the past two years with assistance from GCF grants.



The John Gee Black Historical Center collaborates with Gallia County Local Schools, Gallipolis City Schools, Gallipolis Christian schools and many others to provide history education to students and the greater community. A GCF grant is funding audio and visual equipment that will take the center's programming to the next level.

Gallia County Council on Aging

The Gallia County Council on Aging provided two iPad/tablet training classes for seniors in 2024, thanks to a Healthy Aging Grant from the Ohio Department of Aging. This grant, supported by the AT&T Foundation through GCF, is providing training – as well as devices for at-home use – to 20 additional seniors, increasing their digital literacy and connectivity.

God's Hands At Work

For the past 11 years, Gallipolis-based God's Hands At Work has provided support and resources – everything from housing and food to financial assistance – to help meet the needs of fellow community members. This grant is funding the purchase of two new freezers for the nonprofit's food pantry operations.

John Gee Black Historical Center

Every year, the John Gee Black Historical Center hosts students and visitors from near and far interested in learning about the culture, heritage and contributions of Black Americans living in southeastern Ohio. This grant is funding audio and visual equipment for programming and presentations at the center, advancing its mission and impact.

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Central Ohio

In 2024, a GCF grant helped fund stays for 21 Gallia County families at the Ronald McDonald House – a home away from home while caring for their children who are battling serious illness at Columbusarea hospitals. The grant is continuing that assistance in 2025, providing a safe haven for local families facing difficult times.

Answering the call to lead and serve in Gallia County

In 2023, FAO and its affiliate foundation partners welcomed the inaugural class of Growing Home Fellows, including five individuals living and/or working in Gallia County. In exchange for committing to live, work and volunteer in their communities for five years, these young community builders receive a financial stipend and access to a leadership program and coaching. In 2024, the fellows began implementing service projects in our communities.

A third-grade teacher at Gallia County Local Schools, Samantha Massie is dedicating her Growing Home Fellowship service to creating opportunities for students and community members to engage with the arts.

In 2024, Samantha was part of a team that established the new Musette Performing Arts School in Gallipolis to increase access to the arts in Gallia County. She helped host building workdays and fundraising events, bringing the community together to create a space that reflects the needs of local residents.

Samantha teaches dance classes and choreographs community performances, and this year, she will be the first to offer dance classes for adults at the center.

Fighting hunger in Gallia County – one pig at a time

For the second consecutive year, Gallia County food pantries will have enough sausage to stock their freezers for months, thanks to the growing number of individuals and businesses who are supporting our Fill the Freezer campaign.

Launched in Gallia County in 2023, the campaign invites buyers at the Gallia County Fair Junior Livestock Sale to donate their hog purchases to fill the freezers of the county's food pantries and fight hunger in our communities – one pig at a time. The campaign is held in partnership with the fair board, 4-H members and the Southeast Ohio Foodbank and with corporate sponsorship from Columbia Gas and the NiSource Charitable Foundation, which covered the costs of processing the meat.



Thanks to the community's generosity, the Gallia Community Foundation met its goal for the 2024 campaign – 25 hog donations, resulting in more than 3,100 pounds of sausage, valued at \$14,256. That sausage is being distributed through five organizations battling hunger in Gallia County, where more than 17 percent of the population is food insecure, according to data from Feeding America.


