Funding Guidelines and Grant Application

ELIGIBILITY

The Harrison County Community Foundation was established in 2012 to ensure permanent support for the citizens and communities of Harrison County, and is pleased to announce it is now accepting mini-grant proposals for its 2016 funding cycle. **Any tax-exempt organization serving the Harrison County community is invited to apply.**

FUNDING CRITERIA AND AVAILABILITY

Projects should create access to opportunities or implement a solution for a community need in Harrison County. At this time, the Foundation does **not** accept applications for any event sponsorships or sports-related requests.

For this first round of grants, mini-grants ranging in size from \$250 to \$500 will be awarded.

HOW TO APPLY

In order to receive full consideration for funding, grant requests must include:

- A completed application; and
- 501(c)(3) IRS determination letter.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications are being accepted now through **April 15, 2016**, and all award recipients will be notified directly, no later than May 1, 2016. All grantees will be required to submit a final report at the conclusion of the project, including a detail of expenditures and photos.

All applications should be accurate, complete and include all required documentation at the time of submission to receive full consideration.
