2016 FUNDING GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

Community Foundation for Perry County

ELIGIBILITY

The Community Foundation for Perry County (CFPC) was established in 2012 to ensure permanent support for the citizens and communities of Perry County. CFPC is working to grow grantmaking dollars for projects that improve quality of life in Perry County across five areas CFPC calls the Pillars of Prosperity: arts and culture, community and economic development, education, environmental stewardship, and health and human services. CFPC is pleased to announce its inaugural request for mini-grant proposals, and invites applications from any tax-exempt organization serving the Perry County community.

FUNDING CRITERIA AND AVAILABILITY

Projects should increase quality of life, create access to opportunities or implement a solution for a need in Perry County within one or more of the Pillars of Prosperity: arts and culture, community and economic development, education, environmental stewardship, and health and human services. At this time, the Foundation does **not** accept applications for any event sponsorships or sports-related requests.

For the inaugural round, \$5,000 in funding is available, and up to ten mini-grants will be awarded, ideally across each of the five pillars. Grants will range in size from \$500 to \$1,000.

HOW TO APPLY

In order to receive full consideration for funding, grant requests must include:

- A completed application; and
- 501(c)(3) IRS determination letter.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications will be accepted from **March 14, 2016 to April 15, 2016**, with all grant recipients notified by May 1, 2016. All grantees will be required to submit a final report at the conclusion of the project, including a detail of expenditures and photos.

All applications should be accurate, complete and include all required documentation at the time of submission to receive full consideration.
