2022 Cambridge High School Scholarship Criteria

- Elizabeth Burgess Briggs Trust Fund Graduating senior in the top one-fourth of their class who is pursuing education at an accredited college or university.
- Gregory Cardamone Scholarship Graduating senior involved in high school athletics, who has earned at least two varsity letters, pursuing a bachelor's degree, fulltime, at an accredited college/university. Applicant must be in good academic standing with a history of community service, and volunteer/extracurricular activities. Special consideration will be given to students who have varsity letters in football or wrestling.
- Art Clemenson Scholarship Graduating senior who has maintained a 3.0 grade point average or better, is targeting a career in education, and has a proven track record for serving in the community.
- **Russel B. Diehl Scholarship** Graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education and has financial need.
- Kate Duffey Baker and Hostetler Scholarship Graduating senior, exhibiting
 outstanding ability in the business field and leadership qualities, pursuing a postsecondary education at an accredited college or university.
- John and Rose Dunlavy Scholarship Fund Graduating senior with financial need who is pursuing a bachelor's degree at an accredited 4-year college or university.
- **Erven Trust Fund** Graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited 2-year, 4-year or career/technical center.
