2022 Cambridge High School Scholarship Criteria

- **Elizabeth Burgess Briggs Trust Fund** - Graduating senior in the top one-fourth of their class who is pursuing education at an accredited college or university.
- **Gregory Cardamone Scholarship** - Graduating senior involved in high school athletics, who has earned at least two varsity letters, pursuing a bachelor's degree, fulltime, at an accredited college/university. Applicant must be in good academic standing with a history of community service, and volunteer/extracurricular activities. Special consideration will be given to students who have varsity letters in football or wrestling.
- **Art Clemenson Scholarship** - Graduating senior who has maintained a 3.0 grade point average or better, is targeting a career in education, and has a proven track record for serving in the community.
- **Russel B. Diehl Scholarship** - Graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education and has financial need.
- **Kate Duffey - Baker and Hostetler Scholarship** - Graduating senior, exhibiting outstanding ability in the business field and leadership qualities, pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited college or university.
- **John and Rose Dunlavy Scholarship Fund** - Graduating senior with financial need who is pursuing a bachelor's degree at an accredited 4-year college or university.
- **Erven Trust Fund** - Graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited 2-year, 4-year or career/technical center.
- **Isaac and Carey Esper Scholarship Fund** - Graduating senior football player pursuing a post-secondary degree at an accredited college or university. Student must have a grade point average of 2.7 or higher, have financial need.
- **Ralph G. Ferguson Scholarship Fund** - Graduating senior in good academic standing pursuing a degree at a religiously affiliated college or university.
- **Harvey & Edna Ferrier Scholarship Fund** - One graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education who has financial need.
- **Charles W. and Olive L. Hanna Scholarship Fund** - Graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited college or university who has demonstrated financial need and is not ranked in the top ten percent of the class.
- **Charles E. Jefferson Award** - Graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited college or university who is ranked at the top of the class.

- **McMillen/Masters Scholarship** - Graduating senior with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher majoring in sports medicine, elementary education, criminal justice or juvenile probation at an accredited college or university.
- **Dave and Janet Mitchell Fastpitch Scholarship** - Graduating senior girls fastpitch softball player pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited 2-year, 4-year or career/technical center, who exhibits strength of character, leadership, honesty, discipline and dedication.
- **Mary Moore Scholarship Fund** - Graduating Senior, planning to major in education at an accredited college or university.
- **Joe Mowad Memorial Scholarship Fund** - Graduating senior in the top half of the graduating class pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited 2-year career or technical center.
- **Charles R. Nelson Scholarship Fund** - Graduating Senior pursuing a post-secondary education.
- **Achilles Nicholakis Scholarship Trust Fund** - Graduating senior pursuing a post-secondary education at an accredited 2-year, 4-year or career/technical center.
