

GARY LUCAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES & APPLICATION 2022-2023 Academic Year

Applications accepted beginning March 8, 2022 to April 8, 2022.

The **Gary Lucas Memorial Scholarship** was established in memory of a man whose passion was teaching. After graduating from Barnesville High School, Gary was the first person in his family to go to college. Due to the inspiration of some of his teachers, he knew he wanted to major in education. His first teaching position was at Shenandoah High School where he taught Math and English for nine years. In 1976 he accepted a position as principal of Zane Trace High School in Old Washington, Ohio. Before the year was over, in January of 1977, the state ordered Zane Trace to consolidate with Madison High School into the newly formed Buckeye Trail High School. Bringing two rival schools together was quite a challenge for a young principal, but one Gary embraced.

- Attending an accredited post-secondary institution of higher education; and
- Pursing education as a field of study.
