2024 EDGE OF APPALACHIA – ADAMS COUNTY FUND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Deadline for Primary Consideration – December 12, 2024

The **Edge of Appalachia – Adams County Fund** was established with funding from The Nature Conservancy to provide annual funding to support Adams County residents and organizations to make sure Adams County is an even better place to call home.

The Fund supports scholarships for students seeking degrees in ecology, forestry, wildlife ecology, or related natural resource fields; trade, vocational and technical training in fields that contribute to energy efficiency, agriculture, and land stewardship; and programs that foster diversity, equity, justice, and inclusion (for example, Appalachian Studies or Women's Studies).

Up to \$25,000 may be awarded in scholarships. Applicants and recipients are invited to reapply as long as they continue to meet eligibility criteria.

Eligibility Requirements & Criteria

- Must be a resident of Adams County
- Must be a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in accredited undergraduate, trade, vocational or technical training programs. Students enrolled in graduate programs are not eligible to apply.
- Must be pursuing degrees in one of the following:
 - Ecology, forestry, wildlife ecology, or related natural resource fields.
 - Trade, vocational, or technical programs in fields that contribute to energy efficiency, agriculture, or land stewardship; or
 - Programs that foster diversity, equity, justice, and inclusion, such as, but not limited to, Appalachian Studies or Women's Studies.

Please answer all applicable questions. You are responsible for ensuring <u>all</u> supporting documents are submitted. **This application becomes valid for consideration only when all the following have been received by FAO:**

- **1. Complete and sign the Application Form** (pages 3-5).
- 2. Distribute Letters of Recommendation (pages 6 & 7) Two letter of recommendation forms are attached to give to individuals who can attest to the applicant's academic achievements, character, and dedication to environmental stewardship and diversity, equity, and inclusion. These letters can come from teachers, employers, or community members that can provide an independent and unbiased assessment of the applicant. Give the forms to appraisers as soon as possible and determine how they prefer to submit the forms. You may attach them with your application, or the appraisers may email/mail them separately to FAO (see below).
 - 3. Attach Transcript Students must submit a school transcript (official or unofficial).

- 5. Attach written responses to essay prompts.
- **7. Add <u>scholarships@ffao.org</u> to your email safe senders list** to ensure you receive all communications and award notification emails from FAO.

Process: Applications will be reviewed by the Edge of Appalachia – Adams County Fund committee comprised of Adams County residents which will make funding recommendations according to the scoring criteria shared in the application eligibility. Award recipients will be required to show proof of enrollment. All awards are made payable directly to the institution of enrollment on the recipient's behalf for the purposes and expenses associated with tuition, fees, books, supplies and equipment required (by all in the class) for coursework.

Notification of Awards: FAO will contact scholarship award <u>recipients</u> (only) by January 30, using the email address provided on the application. **Please use a personal email address (not a high school email)** and be sure to check all email folders, including junk/spam folders, for correspondence from FAO.
