

2025 Noble County Community Foundation Scholarship Fund Application

The Noble County Community Foundation Scholarship Fund was established through major donations by the former Dr. Glen B. Taylor Scholarship program, by the former Edmund James Scholarship program and by community donations. The scholarship is valid for any undergraduate or graduate school year of the student's education at an accredited technical college, 4-year college or university or technical or trade school. There is no specific curriculum the student must pursue and at this time the scholarship is not renewable. A total of six \$2,000.00 scholarships each will be given as follows: one graduate of the Class of 2025 from Caldwell HS; one graduate of the Class of 2025 from Shenandoah HS; one to a college student from Caldwell HS; one to a college student from Shenandoah HS. Additionally, one each for a Shenandoah High School graduate and a Caldwell High School graduate who is entering a trade school that is not a traditional four-year school.

- □ ACT and/or SAT Score{s). *NOT applicable to trade school enrollees.
- □ One letter of reference from a current high school or college instructor.
