Applications for the Hazel Post Fisher Memorial Grant, Blake/Underwood Grant, and Southern Perry County Academic Endowment Fund Educational Grant Program are awarded for educational projects that benefit student groups or citizen groups and are consistent with the organization's purpose, i.e., projects that promote academic excellence and provide enrichment opportunities for students or citizens in the Southern Local School District, Perry County, Ohio. Grants are not awarded for the benefit of one individual, as is a scholarship. The following persons/organizations in the Southern Local School District, Perry County, Ohio may apply for a grant project:
 - All currently enrolled students (high school/college enrolled).
 - Current faculty and staff of Southern Local Schools.
 - School clubs and organizations.
 - Nonprofit community organizations serving citizens of Southern Local School District.
- 6. Submit at least two letters of recommendation for your community grant project.
- 7. A final report must be submitted by those who are awarded a grant. The final report should be submitted within 30 days after the completion of the grant project and no later than April 30, 2026. (See attached form on page 4). Failure to complete and submit this form shall make the grantee ineligible for future funding. Grant recipients will also provide a status update on their project in February of their grant term.
- 8. If misuse of a grant is discovered, or suspected, the applicant will be requested to meet with the Distribution/Selection Committee. The Committee will report its findings and make recommendations to the Governing Board. The Board will make a final decision on continuance, withdrawal, or repayment of the awarded funds.
